**About ACWD Water:** The Alameda County Water District (ACWD) was established in 1914 and provides drinking water to residents and businesses in Fremont, Newark and Union City. Its mission is to provide customers with a reliable supply of high-quality water at a reasonable price. ACWD manages and maintains over 930 miles of water main pipelines, 13 reservoirs and water storage tanks, and three treatment facilities and is governed by a 5-member Board of Directors.

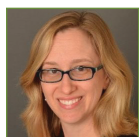

The Delta Conveyance Project (DCP) is a proposal to modernize water infrastructure in the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta by creating an additional point of diversion along the Sacramento River coupled with conveyance facilities in the Delta. The DCP is intended to restore and protect the reliability of State Water Project (SWP) and to ensure California's largest supply of clean water is climate resilient.
